Examinations, frames, and corrective lenses (regular glasses, prescription sunglasses, photochromic lenses and contact lenses) will be provided in a 24-month period, defined as January 1 to December 31 of the following year, for each eligible member.

Covered services and amounts listed below will be paid toward items and services incurred in connection with the subscriber's appointment; **the remaining balance is the subscriber's responsibility.**
